




12. Currently, how close do you feel to God right now?




13. How consistently are you intentionally spending time with God in His Word and prayer each day?




14. Do you feel confident in your ability to read the Bible and engage with the Holy Spirit in a transformative way?




15. Do you regularly experience the Holy Spirit leading you?




16. How would you describe your dependence on God right now?




17. Do you regularly let spiritually mature people speak into your personal life?




18. I feel confident in my ability to disciple other people towards spiritual maturity.




19. What would you say to this statement: "I not only know what my unique spiritual gifts are, but I'm currently using them to serve this local church and beyond."



20. What would you say to this statement: "I not only know my unique story of salvation, but I'm also ready to share it as God brings opportunities for me to do so."




21. Sometimes God calls us to share burdens that someone else is carrying. In the past year, how engaged have you been in sharing the burdens of others whom God has placed in your life?




24. As you consider the leadership of this local church, do you see them as genuinely concerned about your spiritual growth and well-being?



25. As you consider the leadership of this local church, do you see them as genuinely concerned about the well-being of the wider community who aren't part of a local church?




26. We know that God calls us to give. When you think about your ability to give generously to this local church community, how would you say you're doing with that?




Tell us a little bit about your relationship(s) with people who are unconvinced of the Good News....
